Connecting

Four Corners

- Number the corners of the classroom from 1 to 4.
- Select one student to be "It."
- The "It" person sits in the center of the room and closes his or her eyes and counts to 10 while the rest of the players go to one of the four corners in the classroom (as quietly as possible).
- At the count of 10, "It" calls out a number: 1, 2, 3 or 4 and all the kids who are in the corner with that number are out of the game and must sit down.
- "It" closes his or her eyes again, counts to 10 while the remaining players move to their corners. "It" then calls out a number. More students sit down.
- When the game gets down to four people or fewer, each must choose a different corner. If "It" calls out a corner where no one is standing, they must choose again.
